THEME AND SCOPE:

The Autumn Conference 2011 of Operations Research Society of Japan (ACORSJ2011), organized by the Operations Research Society of Japan, will be held in Konan University, Kobe, Japan from September 15 to 16, 2011. An **Asia Session** called **ORSJ-AS** will joint to ACORSJ2011. The main theme of the ACORSJ2011 will be focused on "Information Society and OR".

The Asia Session (ORSJ-AS) is an international symposium around Asia with goals to provide a forum for Asian scientists, researchers, educators, and practitioners to exchange ideas and approaches, to present research findings and state-of-the-art solutions, to share experiences on potentials and limits, on all issues and topics related to the theories and applications of Operations Research. We are particularly interested in submissions that report on experimental and applied research motivated by real-world problems. Theoretical and applied papers are expected to show convincingly the usefulness and efficiency of optimization algorithms discussed in a practical setting. - Title of the paper
- Name(s) and affiliation(s) of the authors
- Postal address
- E-mail address of the authors

FORMAT OF EXTENDED ABSTRACTS

Extend abstracts (2 A4 pages) are due by July 4, 2011, and must be sent to the conference secretary by the following e-mail address. Submission guidelines for the complete extended abstracts accepted are as follows:

- Download the sample paper in the Latex file ([sample.tex](#)), the doc file ([sample.doc](#)) and the PDF file ([sample.pdf](#)).
- Submit electronically the final version of your extended abstracts by PostScript, PDF, or Word files.

REGISTRATION

Registration is required once the abstract is accepted. The registration fee will be 6,000 or free (if you are an invited speaker), but not including conference banquet, lunches and dinners.
